A Home for HOPE Brasil

Hope Brasil has been busy and hard at work as they move towards their goal of ending poverty in Brasil, one family at a time. The local team found the house where the Brazilian Hope mothers will live as they attend the program. Last week the team met with an engineer who will be leading the house remodel. The team is fundraising to pay the costs of the remodeling phase. They are working on the budget plans believing that God is taking care of all their needs. The remodeling might take between 40 to 50 days to be complete. The goal is to have the house ready to furnish by July. Hope Brasil expects in the beginning to start with two single mothers with their children and one senior woman. There is still a lot to be done before the opening; however, there is so much excitement among the Brasil team as they envision what God is about to do in the lives of single mothers in Brazil.



Our precious administrative assistant, Zelene Rodriguez found new ways to give back to our volunteers and seniors. She found joy in serving during the quarantine as she took orders and shopped for those who were unable to get out themselves due to the corona virus.
